

Oh, silly me. Please excuse the error in the just sent August 2015 Newsletter concerning the 9-patch with twist. The following correction should be noted (I was putting this together at 2:30 am, but still!):

When I said that you must piece the center section first before doing the ends I meant that to apply only if you sectioned the block horizontally. The vertical sectioning of this block does not require this. So, this is an example of how the direction of sectioning can change a piecing order. See below:


As you can see from the examples above, how you section this block will make a difference in the piecing order of the center section. So, you should keep this example in mind when thinking through the sectioning and then piecing order for a pieced block like this one.

I hope this further explanation helps with the above examples.
